## JUST OUTSIDE THE TOWN

[Anne Hathaway's Cottage & Gardens](#) (CV37 9HH) is located on Shottery Road, 2 miles from Stratford-upon-

Avon. Transport is usually by car but the house can be reached via a pleasant walk from the town centre which takes approximately 30 mins. The Cottage is well sign posted and parking is available.

[Mary Arden's Farm](#) (CV37 9UN) is three and a half miles from the town centre in Wilmcote. The site is well sign posted and on site free parking is provided. Wilmcote railway station is a very short walk from the Farm.  
**Tudor World Museum - approx. 1 mile out of centre**
